



- 2019-2020 State Aid accounted for 13.1% of budget
- Gap Elimination Adjustment over \$9.55
 million in aid reduction from 2011-2016
- Huntington generally receives less than half of the fully phased-in level of Foundation Aid:
 - ✓ 2019-2020 Foundation Aid \$9,703,433
 - ✓ 2019-2020 Full Phase-In \$19,325,389
 - ✓ Amount underfunded (\$9,621,956)
